

BE IT RESOLVED that the following be and the same is hereby adopted and enacted as a by-law of the Town of Mahone Bay when and if the same has received the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, and that the Town Clerk be and his is hereby instructed to forward the same to the Minister and request his approval hereof.

BY-LAW NO. 17

INTERPRETATION

1.1 This by-law shall be known as and may be cited as the "Interpretation By-law". Short title

2.1 Nothing in this by-law excludes a judicial rule of construction that is applicable to a by-law and not inconsistent with this by-law. Judicial rules of construction preserved

3.1 In this by-law and other by-laws of the Council of the Town unless the context otherwise indicates: Definitions

3.1.1. "bill" means the itemized account in favour of, or against the Town, or any individual or corporation;

3.1.2 "building" includes any structure placed on, over or under land, and every part of the same, and any external chimney, stairway, porch or other fabric used in connection with a building whether affixed to the realty or not including a mobile home.

- 3.1.4 "Clerk" or "Town Clerk" means the Clerk of the Town;
- 3.1.5 "company" includes corporation;
- 3.1.6 "Council" means the Council of of the Town, composed of the Mayor who is deemed to be a member thereof and the councillors of the Town;
- 3.1.7 "councillor" or "member" means a member of the Council;
- 3.1.8 "deputy mayor" means the deputy mayor of the Town;
- 3.1.9 "engineer" or "Town engineer" means the town engineer of the Town;
- 3.1.10 "fence" includes part of any fence;
- 3.1.11 "in writing" or "written" includes printing, lithography and other modes of representing or reproducing words in visible form;
- 3.1.12 "Mayor" means the Mayor of the Town;
- 3.1.13 "mobile home" means any trailer that is
 - 3.1.13.1 designed for or intended to be equipped with wheels, whether or not it is so equipped;
 - 3.1.13.2 constructed or manufactured to provide a residence for one or more person, whether or not it is used for that purpose, or

3.1.13.3 used for the conducting of any business,

but does not include a travel trailer or tent trailer or motor home trailer otherwise designed;

- 3.1.14 "month" means calendar month;
- 3.1.15 "owner" includes a part owner, joint owner, tenant in common or joint tenant of the whole or any part of any real property, and also includes any trustee, executor, guardian, agent, or other person having the care or control of any property within the Town in case of the absence or disability of the person having title thereto;
- 3.1.16 "police court" means the court of stipendiary magistrate for the Town;
- 3.1.17 "policeman" includes constable;
- 3.1.18 "quorum", as applied to the Council means a majority of the councillors constituting the Council; as applied to a committee, board or commission, means a majority of the members constituting the committee, board or commission;
- 3.1.19 "seal" means the Town Seal as provided for in the Town Seal By-law;
- 3.1.20 "solicitor" or "Town solicitor" means the solicitor of the Town;
- 3.1.21 "stipendiary magistrate" means the stipendiary magistrate of the Town and includes the deputy stipendiary magistrate of the Town and also any additional stipendiary magistrate appointed under the provisions of any enactment;

- 3.1.22. "street" includes every street, highway, lane, road, footway, thoroughfare, alley, byway, passage, court, square, sidewalk or bridge and every part thereof lawfully used by and open to the public of the Town;
- 3.1.23. "Town" means the Town of Mahone Bay;
- 3.1.24. "Town Hall" means the building in which the Town Clerk has his office;
- 3.1.25. "trailer" means a vehicle without motive power designed to carry property or passengers wholly on its own structure and to be drawn by a motor vehicle, and includes self-contained units designed to be drawn by a motor vehicle;
- 3.1.26. "treasurer" means the treasurer of the Town;
- 3.1.27. "year" means the financial year of the Town which is the same as the calendar year;
- 3.1.28. "Director of Public Works" means the Director of Public Works of the Town;
- 4.1 Words importing the singular number include the plural number and vice versa.
- 5.1 Words importing the masculine gender include the feminine gender and vice versa.
- 6.1 Words importing persons include companies.
- 7.1 All references to time of day shall be to that system of time in use in the Town at the relevant time whether it be "Atlantic Standard Time" or "Atlantic




Daylight Saving Time".



8.1 The provisions of the Interpretation Act, Chapter 151, R.S.N.S., 1967, as amended, insofar as applicable shall apply to the by-laws of the Town and the interpretation of the words, expressions and clauses therein stated shall be given the same respectively when used in the by-laws of the Town, except insofar as the same are inconsistent with the context or with the intent and object of the by-laws of the Town.
