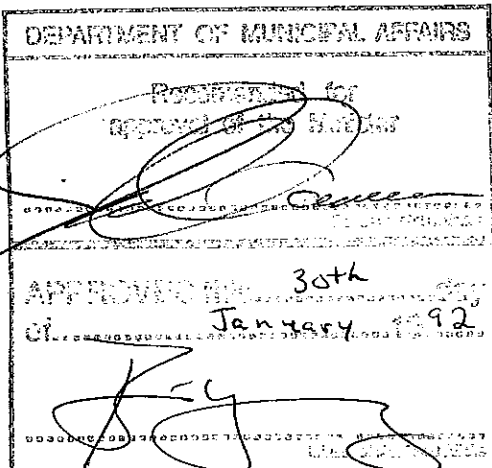


A By-Law Respecting the Town Council

By-Law # 32 of the Town of Mahone Bay entitled a By-Law Respecting the Town Council is hereby amended by deleting the words "eight o'clock" where it appears in Section 2.1 and substituting therefore the words "seven thirty o'clock".

BY-LAW NO. 54

A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE TOWN COUNCIL

1.1 This by-law shall be known as and may be cited as the "Council By-law". Short title.

{2.1} The Council shall hold regular monthly meetings on the second Tuesday of every month at Eight o'clock in the evening at the Town Hall, unless some other place of meeting is designated by resolution of Council; provided that if the second Tuesday of any month shall be a statutory holiday the regular meeting of such month shall be held on the following evening at the same place and hour, unless otherwise resolved by Council at its immediately preceding regular meeting and whenever regularly summoned to attend special meetings. Meetings

3.1 If a quorum is not present within 30 minutes of the time set for the opening of any regular meeting, the same shall be held on the next following evening, not being a statutory holiday, at the same time of day and place. No quorum

3.2 If during a meeting of Council a quorum is lost, the meeting shall adjourn to the next following evening not being a statutory holiday at Eight O'clock in the evening at the same place. Quorum lost

4.1 The Council shall hold such other meetings as may be necessary or expedient for the transaction of Town business to be convened in the manner provided by the Towns Act, and at a time and place to be designated in the notice calling such meeting. Other required meetings

5.1 The Mayor shall, when requested in writing to do so by three members of the Council call a meeting of the Council within three days thereafter, and in the event of his refusal or neglect to do so, such three members may appoint a time and place for holding the meeting, and shall notify the Mayor and the other members of the Council thereof. Special meetings  
The meeting so called shall have the same powers and

other members of the Council thereof. The meeting so called shall have the same powers and authority as if the same had been duly summoned by the Mayor.

5.2 In case of the absence or death of the Mayor and Deputy Mayor, a special meeting of Council shall be summoned at any time by the Town Clerk upon request in writing by any three councillors.

6.1 Written notice shall be given at least twenty-four hours before any meeting of Council.

6.2 Such notice shall specify the time and place of the meeting and shall be signed by the Mayor, Town Clerk or three members of Council and shall be left at the usual place of abode or the usual place of business of each member of the Council; provided that an emergency meeting may be called by the Mayor at shorter notice when necessary, but no business shall be transacted at an emergency meeting other than that indicated in the notice calling the meeting, unless all members of Council are present, and no objection is taken to the discussion or trans-



action of business other than that stated in that notice.



7.1 All former Council By-laws of the Repeal
