A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE TOWN
SOLICITOR.

| 1.1 | This by-law shall be known as and may be cited as the "Solicitor By-law". | Short title |
| 2.1 | The Council may appoint a Barrister of the Supreme Court of not less than two years standing to be Town Solicitor, who shall hold office subject to the provisions of Section 98 of the Towns Act. | Appointment of solicitor |
| 3.1 | The Solicitor shall perform the following duties for the Town: | Duties |
| 3.1.1 | give legal advice and assistance to the Mayor and councillors and the Town officials in the performance of the duties of their respective offices; | |
| 3.1.2 | attend all meetings of the Council when notified and meetings of any committee when requested to do so; | |

- 3.1.3 draft and revise all legal documents required by the Town;
- 3.1.4 take charge of and manage all the legal business connected with the affairs of the Town;
- 3.1.5 draft all proposed legislation on behalf of the Town and all necessary documents in connection therewith; and
- 3.1.6 attend before any committee of the Legislature on behalf of the Town when Council so directs.

4.1 When deemed advisable the Town Solicitor may, with the approval of the Council, retain additional counsel in respect of any matter. Additional Counsel

4.2 When no Town Solicitor has been appointed a Solicitor retained by the Council for any matter or cause shall proceed and shall have and exercise all the rights and duties of the Town Solicitor in respect to said matter or cause as if he were the Town Solicitor, and in accord with his retainer. Retained Counsel

5.1 All former Town Solicitor By-laws are hereby repealed and this by-law substituted therefor. Repeal



