

# Crosswalk Flags in Mahone Bay



Crosswalk flag kits are containers found at either end of a crosswalk which hold flags for pedestrians to carry as they cross the street. Crosswalk flags are intended to improve the visibility of people in crosswalks. **Mahone Bay Town Council has approved crosswalk flag kits for the crosswalk at Main and Clairmont Streets and the two crosswalks at the intersection of Main and Pleasant Street.**



## Trustees Needed!



Community monitoring is essential to the success of the crosswalk flag program. Before crosswalk flag kits can be installed, we need to identify trustees for **each** specific crosswalk.

Trustees will commit to:

- Visually inspect the kits three times a week
- Ensure that flags are supplied and distributed evenly
- Ensure that kits are in good repair
- Check in with Town Hall when supplies or repairs are needed.
