Town of Mahone Bay announces new Chief Administrative Officer

MAHONE BAY – Mayor David Devenne is pleased to announce the appointment of Dylan Heide as the new Chief Administration Officer for the Town of Mahone Bay. Mr. Heide's appointment is the culmination of an extensive search process.

Originally from Mahone Bay, Mr. Heide is a graduate of Dalhousie University's Master of Public Administration Program and comes to the Town of Mahone Bay from the Town of Shelburne, where he has served as CAO for the past six years. Mr. Heide has previously worked for several municipal governments as well as for the Government of Nova Scotia and the Government of Nunavut.

Mr. Heide states: "I am truly excited to return home to Mahone Bay to take on the role of CAO for the Town. I look forward to joining the Town of Mahone Bay's team and rejoining my community of friends and neighbours after many years working away from my home."

Of his most recent position, Heide noted "Shelburne is a truly special community with a great Council and a committed staff. I am fortunate to have had the opportunity to live, learn and work there for the past six years."

The Mayor underscored his enthusiasm for Heide's appointment, "Dylan brings a full depth of knowledge of public administration as well breadth of management experience to the CAO role.
